## **Scholarship Application for Alpine Meadows Ski Team Foundation**

### **Mission Statement:**

**Alpine Meadows Ski Foundation** is non-profit organization dedicated to supporting young amateur athletes interested in developing skills in competitive Alpine Skiing and Snowboarding.

Our primary goal is to provide scholarships to young athletes for the Junior Development and Development programs who need financial assistance in order to engage in competitive Skiing and Snowboarding. Additionally, we offer assistance to athletic charities and organizations for disabled athletes.

With money generated through fundraisers, the foundation purchases equipment, pays for training clinics, and supports competitive teams at Alpine Meadows.

### **Rules and Eligibility:**

Only full scholarships are available. Each qualified recipient will have available to them:

- One 2011/2012 ski season lift ticket at Alpine Meadow
- Paid team membership fees
- Team coaching

Scholarships do not include personal equipment, clothing or travel expenses to races. To be considered applicants must submit all materials outlined below by **October 30th**:

- Application filled out
- 2011 family federal and state tax returns
- 2010-2011 school report card
- Application letter (written by athlete)

Girls and boys ages 7 -15 years of age with financial assistance needs and a desire to participate in a ski or snowboard team at Alpine Meadows Ski Resort.

**Schedule of Due Dates:**

Following is the application process schedule and submission procedure: Applications are due to Catherine Nottage by **October 30th**. A scanned/ emailed copy of the application can be accepted, if you are unable to mail your documents in time. A hard copy will be required for our records.

Scholarship notifications will take place on **November 9th**.

Scholarship recipients will have until **November 23rd** to notify scholarship committee of their acceptance and to confirm their spot on the team roster.

Note: Review of late applications cannot be guaranteed.

**Participation Requirements:**

If accepted, the athlete must plan to participate in 75% of the program, including training and competitions, if applicable. If the athlete does not participate in 75% of program activities, a verbal warning will be issued. If lack of required participation continues, a written warning will be issued with potential loss of scholarship.

Note: All scholarship recipients' parents must volunteer within the foundation. Volunteer assignments will be determined on skills and availability.

- not leave the group without notifying an adult (coach).

If conduct is less than satisfactory, a discussion and warning will be issued. Upon a second offense the athlete's privileges may be eliminated or suspended.
